It reflects ecumenism as a vocation and the influence, theology and work of (monastic and lay) ecumenical communities. We will have the pleasure to attend the keynote lectures of two experienced ecumenists who themselves live in ecumenically engaged communities: Br. Richard from Taizé and Dr. Joan Patricia Back from the Focolare community. We will also have two sessions for short paper presentations where you can present your work and discuss it with international peers. Besides these, there will be plenty of time for informal discussion and getting to know each other around common meals and cups of coffee or tea.
